of our Lord God One thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty three I Zebulon  
Hollingsworth of Cecil County in the Province of Maryland Inholder being  
of Proper Mind and Memory thanks be given unto God therefore cautioning  
to Mind the Mortality of my Body, and knowing that it is appointed  
for all Men to dye do Make and Ordain this Instrument of Writing  
to be my Last will and Testament in Manner and forme following  
Imprimis my will and Desire is that all my Just Debts and funeral  
Charges be paid by my Executors. Secondly In my will and Desire that  
my Executors pay unto my Daughter Deborah Cowsey Six Silver and  
Shore being the Value of thirty Shillings, it to be given in full  
of all Claims or Demands against my Estate. Thirdly In my  
will and Desire that my Son Jeps Hollingsworth have One Hundred  
and fifty Aeres of Land where Hugh Michoffoy did live or now lives  
to him his heirs and assigns for ever in full of Claims or Demands  
against my Estate. Fourthly In my will and Desire that my  
two Sons Zebulon and Levi Hollingsworth Have part of the tract of <sup>land</sup> called  
Prices Adventure, and Part of Successer beginning at a point called  
Fishing or Wharfs Point on the Main Branch of Elk River and running  
from thence North West till it strikes the Division line between  
Robert Evans and this Testator, of Prices Adventure and Seventy  
five Aeres of Wood Lands to be laid out along and adjoining the North  
West Line of Friendship in a Long Square also thirty five Aeres of Marsh  
called the Crisples to the said Zebulon Hollingsworth and Levi Hollingsworth  
their heirs and assigns for ever. Fifthly In my will and Desire that my  
Son Henry Hollingsworth Have that Tract or parcel of Land that I the  
Testator bought of Simon Johnson beginning at the River & at the lower  
-most line of said Tract running North twenty two Degrees West One  
Hundred and Eighty One Perches from thence with a straight and direct  
Line to the North East Corner of the Original Tract of Land called  
Friendship and all the Lands that lye to the Eastward of the afore-  
said Line to be the Right & Property of Henry Hollingsworth his  
heirs and assigns for ever & further I give unto my Son Henry  
ten Aeres of Marsh part of a tract of Land or Marsh called  
Hollings Point now in the Possession of Adam Dobson lying  
between little Elk and Mill Creek to him his heirs and assigns  
& further I give unto my Son Henry One Negro Wench named  
Jareto unto him his heirs and assigns also a piece of Marsh lying

on the South East Corner of Tolburt's March, to him and his heirs  
 Southly In my will and Desire that my Son Jacob have my now Dwelling  
 House the Remaining Part of my now Dwelling Plantation also the  
 Remaining Part of the <sup>land</sup> below Dogwood Run that is not already  
 willed away out of the Tract of Land call'd Friendship also ten acres of  
 Swamp call'd by the Name of Swamp to the said Jacob Hollingsworth  
 his heirs and assigns. Seventhly In my will and Desire that my Son  
 Thomas have all the Clear and Wood Land that lyes to the West Ward of  
 Dogwood Run being Part of Friendship where Richard Bradley now  
 lives to him the said Thomas Hollingsworth his heirs and assigns -  
 Eighthly In my will and Desire that my Son Stephen Hollingsworth  
 have the South East Myrtle or half Part of what Remains of Clements  
 Adventure not Claimed by the heirs of William Mumfery to him his  
 heirs & assigns the other half part to the lawfull heirs of James  
 Armstrong - Ninthly In my will and Desire that my Son  
 John Hollingsworth have the Tract of Land call'd worth lottel to him  
 the said John Hollingsworth his heirs & assigns - Tenthly In my  
 will and Desire that my Son Henry Hollingsworth pay unto my  
 Son Sam<sup>r</sup> Hollingsworth Sixty five pounds current Money when  
 he arrives at the Age of twenty one years - Eleventhly In my  
 will and Desire that my <sup>son</sup> Jacob Hollingsworth pay unto my Son  
 John Hollingsworth fifty pounds current Money when he  
 arrives at the Age of twenty one yrs. its further my will and  
 Desire that my Son Sam<sup>r</sup> pay unto my Son Samuel Hollings  
 worth Sixty five pounds current Money when he arrives at  
 the Age of twenty one years - Twelfthly In my will that  
 my Daughter Lydia Hollingsworth have a Quarter part of a Lot  
 of Land lying in Charles Town Number Eighty two one feather  
 Bed and furniture to the Value of twelve pounds Current Money  
 two cows with calves over and above her equal Share of my movable  
 estate to her the said Lydia Hollingsworth her heirs and assigns -  
 Thirteenthly In my will that my Son Zebulon Hollingsworth  
 Henry Levi and Jacob Hollingsworth their heirs Executors adm<sup>r</sup> or  
 assigns shall yearly & every year pay unto my Son David Holling  
 worth or his Guardian the Sum of Seven pounds ten Shillings  
 Current Money each of them during his Natural life being due  
 from each the said Zebulon Hollingsworth Henry Levi and  
 Jacob Hollingsworth as Grossed Rent on the Lands left them  
 by my last will and Testament - ~~fourteenth~~ In my will

 they arrive at the age of Fourteen years old then to bind them out  
 to such Trade as my Executors shall think best for them  
Sixteenth In my will and Desire that my Cousin Adam Dabson have  
 and Enjoy one Hundred Acres of Land where he now lives called  
 Successor also thirty Acres of Marsh called Hollings Point lying  
 Mill Creek and between said Mill Creek and ten Acres of Marsh  
 Part of the said Hollings Point willed to my son Henry Hollingsworth  
 to him the said Adam Dabson his heirs and assigns for ever  
Seventeenth In my will that my Movable Estate be equally divided am<sup>t</sup>  
 my Children as follows Lebulon Henry Levi Jacob Lydia Thomas Stephen  
 John & Samuel Hollingsworth Eighteenthly and lastly it is my  
 will and Desire that my well beloved Wife Mary Henry & Susid  
 Hollingsworth be appointed constituted made and Ordained my  
 only and Sole Executors of the my last will and Testament I do hereby  
 wholly Disallow revoke and <sup>cancel</sup> annul all and every other wills and  
 Legacies and Executors by me in any way before this time or made  
 willed and bequeathed ~~that~~ and Confirming this and no  
 other to be my last will and Testament In Witness I have here  
 unto set my Hand and put my Seal the Day and Year first written
